### Who We Are

#### *Leonard Kirtz School*

Leonard Kirtz School provides comprehensive programs and education for school age children with developmental disabilities. The content of the program is designed to provide social, academic, and vocational programs geared to the individual functioning level of each student and follows the curriculum as defined by the Ohio Department of Education Content Standards.

Certified teachers and specialists provide instruction through the implementation of Individual Education Plans (IEP). IEP goals concentrate on developing skills in communication, self-help, functional daily living, social interaction, cognitive development, vocational preparation, and vocational training.

In addition to classroom programs:

- a. School-age students receive instruction in several key departments each week from certified instructors.
- b. Post-Secondary (option 23) students receive vocational and independent living instruction in specialized classes.

Leonard Kirtz School offers related services in the areas of speech, physical therapy, and contracted occupational therapy to those students in need of intervention. Other related services available to all students include nursing, transportation, and case management.

It is the Board's intent that all students who enter Leonard Kirtz School increase their cognition, and benefit physically and vocationally, so they may reach their fullest potential.

The MCBDD currently serves 72 students from 14 local school districts.

## Leonard Kirtz Summer Camp 2019

MCBDD/Leonard Kirtz holds an annual summer camp for students with special needs from the ages of 6-22.

The summer camp will blend continued work in academics and IEP goals as well as social and recreational activities and based in effective practices and positive behavior supports.

Camp is five weeks from June 17<sup>th</sup> – July 26<sup>th</sup> (closed the week of July 4<sup>th</sup>). Daily camp is 9 am –3 pm daily with limited transportation through MCBDD for eligible riders.

Camp Cost \$500 per camper (\$100 deposit due at time of application \*\*if parent is responsible for pay\*\*)

Camp can be considered Extended School Year Services for eligible students/school districts through continued work on academic and behavioral goals as written on student's current IEP.

Students who have attended the previous year, or are full time attendees of the school program receive first priority in enrollment. All other spaces are filled in order of completed applications.

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This year's program will be Occupations/Animals with weekly themes based on the theme. Classroom lessons and activities will incorporate the theme as well as weekly events for all campers.

Daily activities will be based on building Reading, Math and Social skills.
